





**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

India (here in after referred to as "ROFPC")

**WHEREAS**

- SIMS and ROFPC desiring to conduct faculty / academic exchange program.
- SIMS and ROFPC desiring to promote and develop co-operation in project work and research intend by this MoU to establish and operate a mutually agreed program with a view to establishing an effective and long standing educational and research alliance.
- It has been considered expedient to agree in writing to participate jointly as per the expertise and logistics available with both the parties.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions herein contained, the parties here to agree as follows:

### **Objective:**

The principle object of this MoU is to -


- Provide platform for the students and faculties of participant institutes for education and research at College Of Education and ROFPC.
- Provide participant institute with the opportunity to teach or conduct research.
- Match faculty members from the collaborating member institutions in the teaching of a course.
- Explore student projects in areas of mutual interest.
- Explore online interaction to bring students and faculties of participating institutes closer.
- Define the guidelines within which the above referred collaboration shall function, the scope of work each party to this MoU shall perform and the modality by which it shall be implemented at SIMS and ROFPC.

### **Obligations of the Parties**

#### **Responsibilities of College Of Education and ROFPC:**

Both the parties agree that, they shall provide the following to each other with mutual consent:

- Furnishing technical and process documentation for programs in member Institutes.
- Provide the facilities for carrying out academics/ teaching in the institutes viz. lecture hall, seminar hall, projector, computers etc. as required and availability in both institutes.
- Provide the requirements for carrying out research work of students and faculties by sharing the available facilities viz. laboratories, equipment's, analytical instruments, animal house etc.as per the availability in both institutes.
- Provide the facilities for collaborative research work for the students and faculties of both institutes.
- Provide the infrastructural facilities and expertise required to conduct collaborative research work.

### Execution and Operational Review:

- To manage the execution of this MoU, the parties agree to constitute an advisory committee consisting of two members each from both the parties. The advisory committee shall meet at least once in 3 months either at office of SIMS or ROFPC.
- **College Of Education or ROFPC** will review the operations of the program twice a year. The purpose of the review shall be to assess the planning and operations of the program including, but not limited to its quality, timeline, performance and progress. The subject of expansion and amplification of the scope of this MoU will also be discussed during this meeting.

### Exchange of information and confidentiality:

The term "information" includes notes, presentations, academic documents, scientific or technical data, results and / or methods of investigation and other information intended to be provided, exchanged or arising under the areas of cooperation identified in the MoU. The parties shall take all measures to protect the secrecy of and avoid disclosure to any third parties and unauthorized use of the information which is confidential and outside the public domain. Individuals who will come into possession of privileged information shall be required to sign a **mutual non-disclosure agreement** to the above effect.

### General Provisions:

- 1) The institution organizing an item of work shall have the nodal responsibility for mobilizing resources and the conduct of such works.
- 2) The parties shall discuss and finalize the detailed scope of work to be performed by each party to fulfill the objective of this MoU and agree on the financial considerations for the same.
- 3) Except as agreed above in (2), each party shall bear the respective costs of carrying out the obligations under this MoU.
- 4) Neither party shall make a claim against the other party for any expenditure unless such expenditure has been agreed upon in writing between the parties.
- 5) The implementation of the areas and forms of cooperation identified in this MoU shall be subject to the availability and convenience of faculty, research-scholars, students and infrastructure facilities at the party's workplace.
- 6) Any research publications and commercially exploitable innovations arising out of the joint research projects shall be jointly published or patented as appropriate.

**Relationship of the Parties:**

This MoU is not intended to create a relationship such as a partnership, joint venture, agency or employment relationship. Neither party may act in a manner that expresses or implies a relationship other than independent contractor nor bind the other party. Participation in this MoU shall not prevent either party from entering into similar MoUs with other institutions.

**Assignment:**

Neither party may assign or otherwise transfer any of its rights or obligations under this MoU, without the prior written consent of the other party.

**Use of other Party's Name:**

Either of the Parties shall not use the other's name, trademarks, seal, photograph or any other identifying or proprietary information in catalogues, advertising and promotional materials or other material, unless the other party has reviewed and approved of the proposed use.

**Validity:**

Unless extended by the Parties in writing this MoU shall remain valid and effective for a period of five (5) year from the date of execution here of and can be extended for a further period to be mutually agree dup on. Either Party may terminate this MoU by sending a prior written notice of not less than one (1) month. The provisions of this MoU shall survive the expiry or termination of this MoU for a period of five (5) years.

**Law:**

- Disputes and claims arising from this MoU or its interpretation, breach, performance or termination, unless settled by mutual MoU in writing shall be finally settled by arbitration in a Court of Law in Ahmednagar, Maharashtra, India. The language of arbitration shall be English and Indian law shall apply. The award of arbitration shall be final and binding on the parties.

**Miscellaneous:**

- This MoU supersedes any prior oral or written understandings and constitutes the entire MoU between the parties with respect to its subject matter, and no modification, amendment or waiver there of shall be effective unless in writing and signed by both parties.
- Neither party shall make any claim against or be liable to the other for any loss or damage including but not limited to any consequential damages or loss of profits arising from any discussions, actions taken in reliance on this MoU. Unless agreed by mutual consent in writing this MoU will expire automatically on 8<sup>th</sup> October, 2024
